It is a pleasure to send you this important information about one of Phi Kappa Phi's award programs, the Promotion of Excellence Grants (PEG).

The PEG program is designed to provide support to Phi Kappa Phi members and chapters as they design and implement programs and activities that advance excellence in higher education. Projects supported by the PEG Program may be either development-focused or research-focused. Preference will be given to projects that are multi-disciplinary in nature.

The deadline for receipt of applications at the Society Headquarters is **January 27, 2006**. A total of \$40,000 is available for Grant Period Two. The maximum amount of any single grant will be \$10,000. It is expected that the minimum grant award would be \$2,000. Any Phi Kappa Phi member, team of members, chapter, or team of chapters of the Society is eligible to apply. Remember that the project director must be an active member of Phi Kappa Phi, although the project team may include non-members. There is no limit to the number of applications that may be submitted by an individual or chapter; however, no more than one grant will be approved to each chapter or member of the chapter during the triennium.
